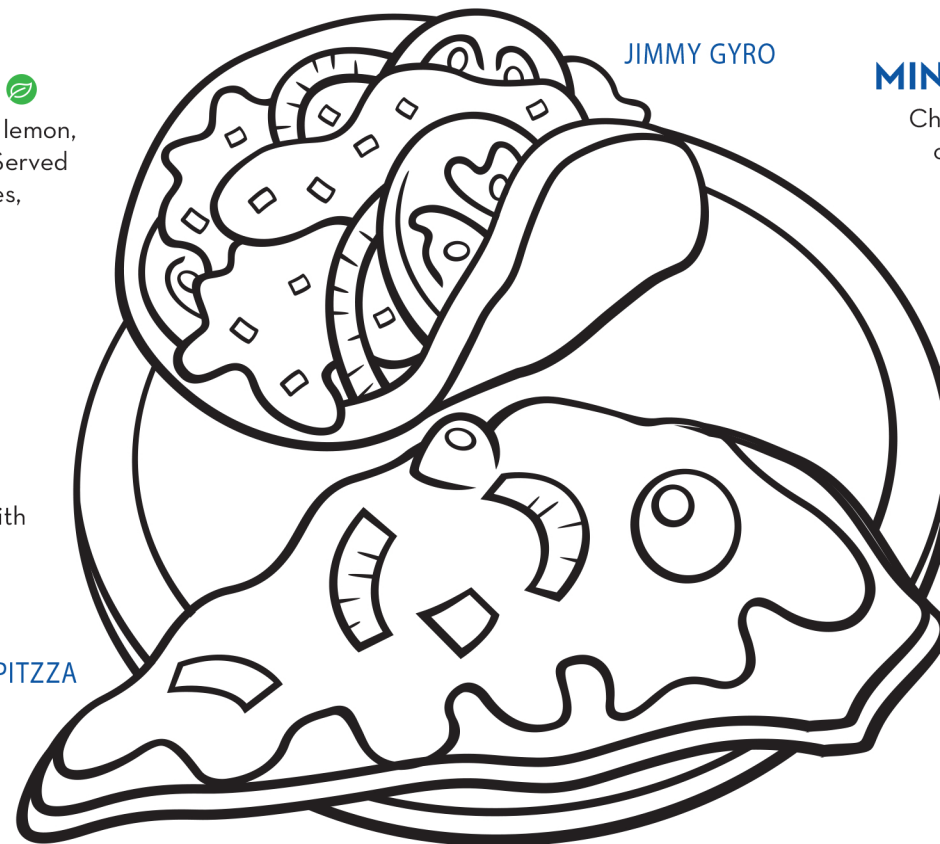

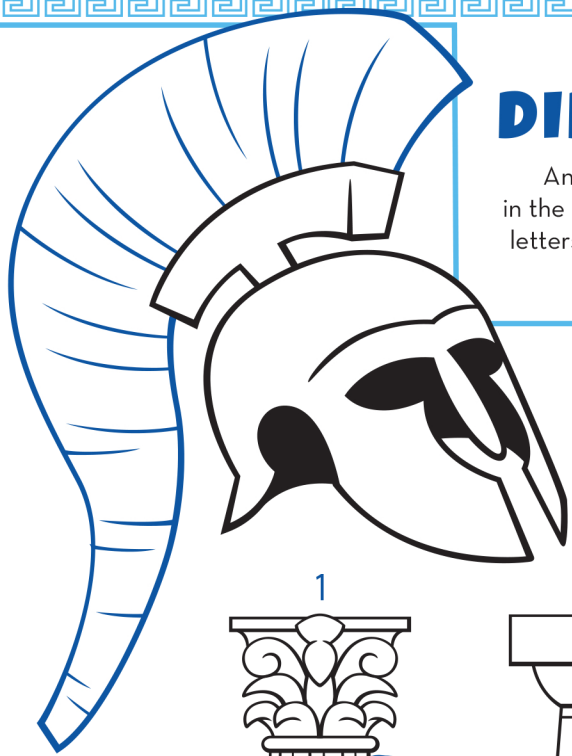
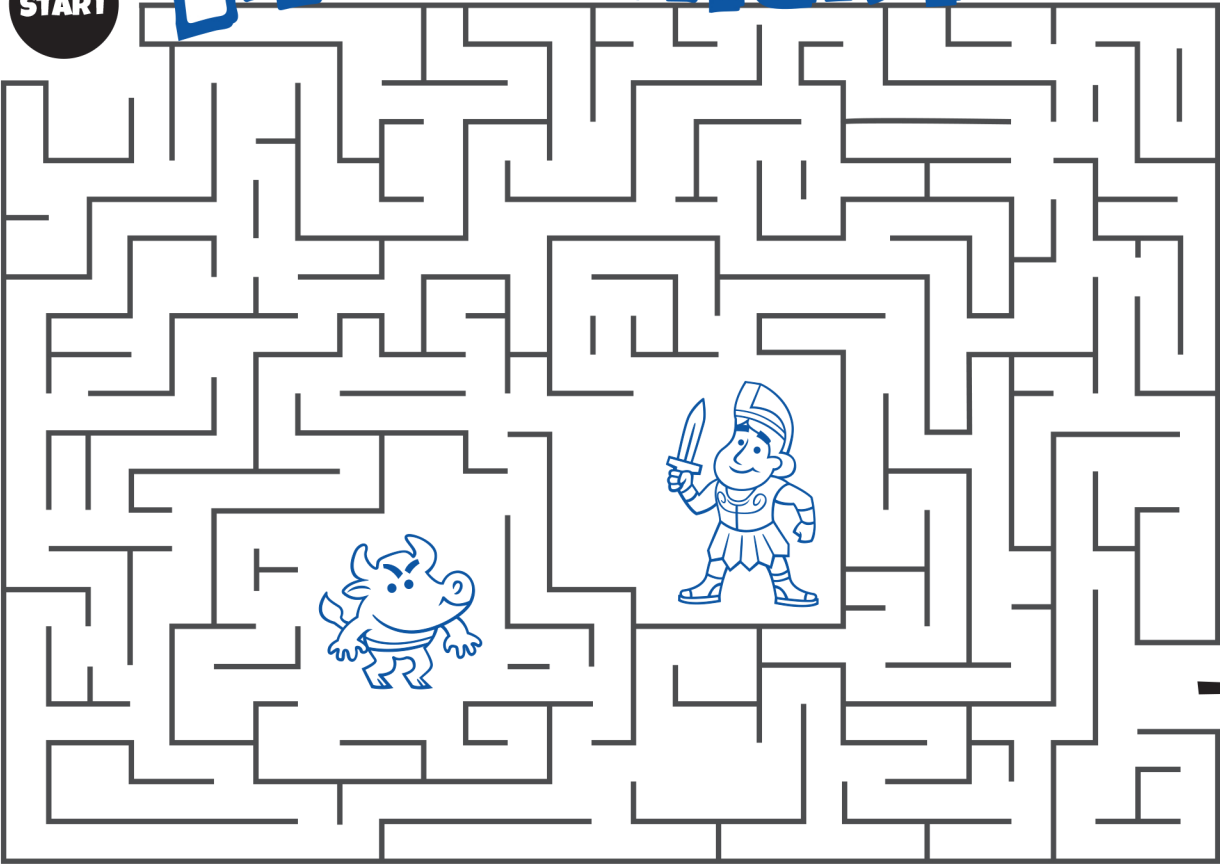

**Corinthian:** The most decorated columns, usually with leaves and floral patterns.

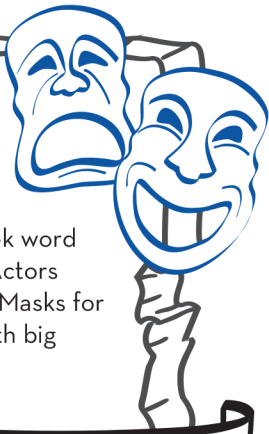

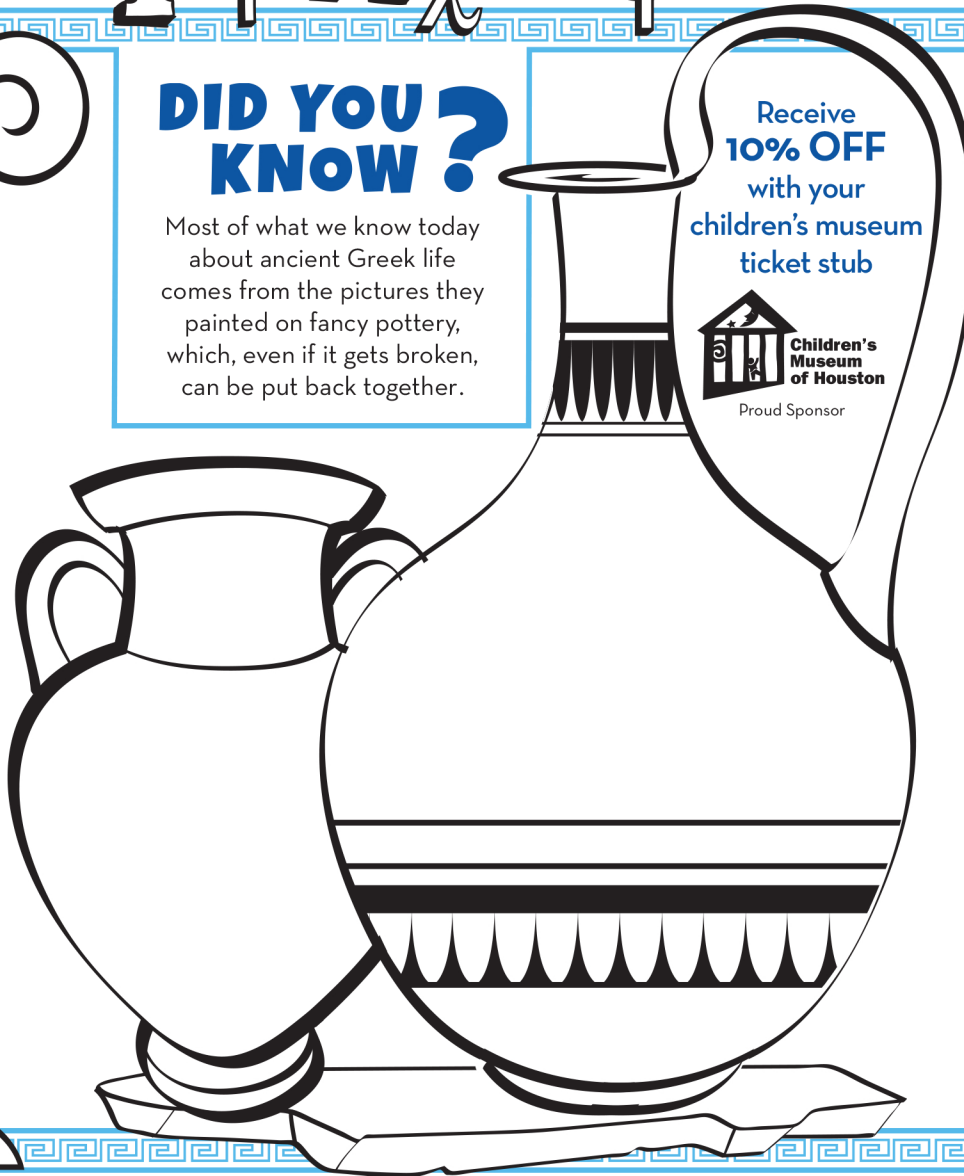
